

Important Updates:

Following a review by the Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE) changes to local authority ward boundaries which came into effect earlier this month have created 46 new wards, affecting 25 of London's 32 boroughs.

This has a number of implications for the Met, in particular our Neighbourhoods Teams. We are working at pace to respond to these changes and ensure every new, existing or changed London ward has their own neighbourhood policing team. In the interim, every ward will still be policed with a local team who will continue to prioritise local issues, providing a neighbourhood policing service.
